- Provide a general, and when required more complex, legal advice, advocacy and representation to clients of the Commission across the practice areas of family, criminal and civil law in the Magistrates Court.
- Participate in Community Legal Education Programs which includes preparation and delivery of legal training programs to stakeholders, advisers and others when required.
